- No leverage or short-selling permitted.

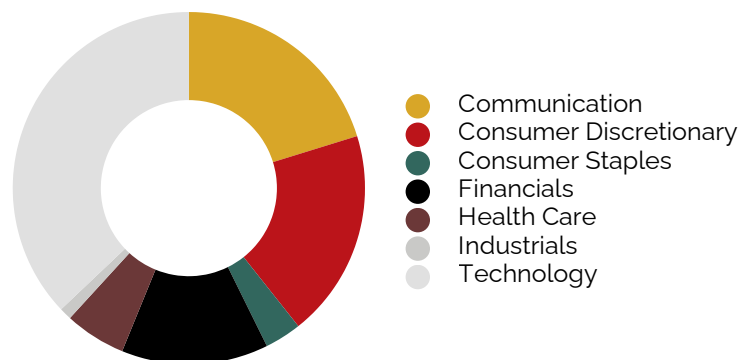
